#### **Responses and Rebids in Uncontested auctions**

#### With what hands will responder pass the opening bid?

Responder may pass with any hand, but normally the pass is based on an educated guess or a long suit in the major.

#### Meanings of other responses and rebids:

All suit bids are to pass or correct.

2NT is a forcing enquiry, and opener will bid his corresponding minor with a minimum hand and his major with a maximum hand. Opener may jump rebid naturally with very good distribution. 3NT is forcing with a strong hand and a good suit.

## **Competitive Agreements**

**Responses after opponent's DBL** (including Pass, RDBL and expected follow-ups)

Pass expressed a wish to play there if it's the opener's suit.

RDBL is strong, with penalty interest.

Any suit bid is to pass or correct.

## **Responses after opponent's overcall:**

DBL is for penalties, either with trumps or expecting partner to have them.

Suit bids are to pass or correct.

# Rebids after 4<sup>th</sup> hand DBLs the response:

As undisturbed..

**Rebids after 4<sup>th</sup> hand overcalls:** 

Opener doesn't have to bid voluntarily with a minimum hand.

Double shows the suit after the 2NT response
